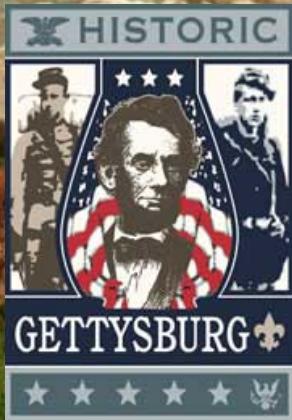


Pack 802 Family Camping Gettysburg, PA



17-20 October 2019

Join Pack 802 in Gettysburg for a long weekend of camping, history, and fun! Weekend activities include visit to the Gettysburg museum and cyclorama, hiking the Billy Yank Heritage trail, walking tour of historic Gettysburg, flag retirement ceremony, and several campground sponsored activities (crafts, karaoke, trick-or-treating). Cost is \$5/person/night and includes all food. Scouts that participate in all activities may earn up to three of five [Gettysburg Heritage Trails](#) patches.

Uniform: Field uniform is required for scouts and scouters Saturday at museum, battlefield hike, and flag retirement ceremony. Scouts and adults are encouraged to wear activity uniform for all other days. Scouts that wish to trick-or-treat on Saturday evening at the campground may bring a costume.

Heritage Trail Information:

Scouts that wish to participate in the Heritage Trail program will have the opportunity to complete three activities in the Heritage Trail Guide while visiting the Gettysburg National Military Park. Adults will lead scouts in a group discussion relevant to the civil war for each of these activities.

1. Scouts will view the film 'A New Birth of Freedom' and the interactive Cyclorama experience while at the Museum-Visitor Center (Museum admission paid by Pack).
2. The Billy Yank trail is an approximate 10-mile loop hike through significant battlefield sites on the West side of the visitor's center. We have divided the hike into two segments of approximately 3 hours each to make it easier for all scouts to complete; however, families that do not want to or unable to complete the hike are encouraged to participate in alternative program suggestions at the campground. Limited parking is available at select sites along the route.
3. The Historic Gettysburg trail is an approximate 3-mile loop that visits portions of the historic village of Gettysburg

Additional Notes:

- Scouts are not permitted to stand, climb, or hang from cannons and monuments within the park.
- There will be little shade available during the Billy Yank and Historic Gettysburg hikes/walks. Everyone should have sun protection and sufficient water for the entire hike. We will be packing bagged lunches for the portion of the hike on Saturday.
- Portions of the hike will follow along side of an active road. Scouts will need to use caution to avoid traffic.
- Backpacks are not permitted at the visitor center. They may be left in vehicles and picked up before hike
