ABOUT CUB SCOUTS AT PACK 802

Cub Scouting is a family oriented program designed to help our youth develop into their best selves by learning to live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law. The Cub Scout program promotes character development, citizenship, personal fitness, and outdoor skills but is mainly focused on kids having fun!

Pack 802 is open to youth boys and girls in grades K-5. We are a family friendly pack and all family members are invited to participate in our events. All of our leaders are volunteers and we encourage every family to use their talents to contribute to our shared leadership model.

DEN MEETINGS

Most Cub Scout meetings occur within a den. Each den is composed of about 5-10 boys and girls in the same grade (K-5) and is led by adult volunteers. Our dens typically meet every other Tuesday evening from 6:30-8:00PM at Grove Presbyterian Church when school is in session. Dens also periodically meet off site to perform activities including hikes, service projects, first responder visits, troop visits, etc. Offsite meetings may occur on alternative evenings but will be scheduled in advanced to accommodate the maximum number of families possible. All meetings/activities are published to the Pack calendar.

ACTIVITIES

Pack 802 typically plans at least one pack-wide activity each month in addition to regular den meetings. The pack typically offers 3-5 overnight camping events each year. Other events include the pinewood derby, rain gutter regatta, bike rodeo, hikes, historical site visits, museum visits, indoor rock climbing, parades, service projects, STEM activities and much more!
