Financial Overview Sheet

This sheet provides an overview of the income and expenses detailed in Pack 802's annual budget including projected cost to families. This sheet is a living document and actual costs are subject to change based on the number of scouts registered, family participation in events, and success of Pack fundraisers. Pack 802 desires to make scouting accessible to as many families as possible and therefore strives to keep annual dues as low as possible. As displayed in the tables below, the expenses paid by the pack for each scout exceed the cost of dues. Pack 802 is heavily dependent on fundraising to cover baseline scout expenses and subsidize event costs for all. If pack fundraising goals are not met, projected out-of-pocket expenses will increase. Through fundraising, it is possible for thrifty scouts to earn their own way. See fundraising sheet for additional information.

- 1. Fall dues shall be reduced by \$5.00 if scout opts-in to use electronic handbook and resources (checklist, worksheets) in lieu of paper handbook. All electronic resources necessary to complete Tiger through Arrow of Light rank advancement are available at pack802md.com/resources.
- 2. Fall dues shall be reduced by \$5.00 if scout opts-in to trade gently used neckerchief and slide from prior den in exchange for a gently used neckerchief and slide for new den. This reduction is dependent on participation from other families and is available as supplies last.
- 3. Spring dues shall be waived for scouts that participate in three popcorn show-and-sell fundraisers, or participate in two show-and-sell fundraisers and complete one sheet of individual popcorn sales (30 customers).
- 4. Scout registration fee was increased by Boy Scouts of America from \$24.00 to \$33.00 effective 1 December 2017.
- Cost to families can be further reduced through fundraising. A portion of all funds earned by scouts is saved in the scout's individual account and can be used to pay for any scouting expense described on this sheet. See pack802md.com/pages/fundraising for additional information.
