

Sunday Breakfast. Oatmeal, muffins, granola bars










Site Information:

Site. From Turkey Point turn left on campground road. We are camping at group sites red fox and river otter designated by green shaded area above.

Parking. Parking along the dirt road adjacent to campsite. **Facilities.** Full bathroom/hot water showers at bath house. **Water.** Potable water spigot is available near camp entrance. Pack will provide communal water jug to refill water bottles but all must sanitize hands before each use and cups/bottle lip must not touch the spout of water jug.

Mess. Pack will maximize use of disposable plates/silverware to reduce need for dishes.
