Overview: Come out and complete in the Harford District Fall Camporee! This event provides our Webelos scouts an opportunity to apply leadership and outdoor skills in preparation for greater independence when joining a Scouts BSA Troop. Scouts from multiple units across Harford District will be attending camporee and competing in scouting spirit and games with a sports/athletics theme. Primary advancement opportunities include Cast Iron Chef and Outdoor Adventurer. Additional advancement opportunities include portions of Stronger, Faster, Higher and Sports adventures. Finally, scouts will get to meet and interact with some local Scouts BSA troops. Cost is \$10/person and includes all meals and District Fee. **Uniform:** Pack 802 Activity Uniform (Maroon T-shirt) on Saturday. Field uniform is not required for this event.

Arrival: All participants arriving on Friday must check-in together as a group before heading to the camp site. Please plan to arrive at the Camp Saffran Parking lot between 6:00-6:15pm. We will shuttle all gear to the campsite using one or two vehicles. Please bring a wagon if you do not want to wait to shuttle gear. Please let Jon know if you will be arriving late on Friday, Saturday morning, or if your scout must depart camp on Saturday to attend another event (sports game etc).



<u>Scout Duty Roster:</u> One of the primary benefits of this event is to provide older scouts an opportunity to develop leadership skills and greater self-sufficiency by performing tasks that are frequently performed by adult leaders on Cub Scout camping trips. Webelos scouts will be assigned and are expected to perform the following responsibilities while at camp: Fill water cooler, meal preparation, meal cooking, wash dishes, camp cleanup, trash disposal, gather firewood and other duties as required.

<u>Adult Assistance</u>: The Camporee staff has requested that each unit be prepared to provide adult assistance to judge/score or lead select stations on Saturday. A majority of the stations can be scored by adults with the group; however, we may need to provide adult leadership at a station independent from our group. The camporee staff will provide additional information and station sign-up at check-in.
