2022-2023 Financial Overview Sheet

This sheet provides an overview of the income and expenses detailed in Pack 802's annual budget including the projected out-of-pocket cost to families. This sheet is a living document and actual costs are subject to change based on the number of scouts registered, event participation, and fundraiser participation. Pack 802 makes scouting accessible to as many families as possible by keeping scout dues below actual costs. The pack spends approximately \$100 more per scout each year than what is collected in dues. Our program is heavily dependent on fundraising to cover baseline scout expenses and subsidize event costs for all. Projected out-of-pocket expenses will increase if fundraising goals are not met. Scouts that participate in fundraising can easily earn their own way while collectively supporting the entire Pack!

- 1. Please note that the actual registration fee paid to the BSA varies based on month joining. If you complete an online application to join scouts and pay the national fee directly, your dues owed to Pack 802 will be reduced by the amount paid to the BSA.
- 2. Lions (kindergarten) may purchase blue Cub Scout Field Uniform shirt or the optional Lion T-shirt. The Lion T-shirt is \$14.99.
- 3. Out-of-pocket costs may be significantly reduced or eliminated through fundraising. This year Pack 802 is splitting popcorn sales revenue 30/70 between the unit and the scout. The portion of revenue provided to the scout is reserved in the pack's bank account and can be used to pay for or reimburse any scouting expense described on this sheet. Scouts earn 24.5% of the retail value of popcorn sold face-to-face at show and sells or wagon sales and 21% of the retail value of popcorn sold through online ordering.

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The following table forecasts out-of-pocket and pack covered expenses for each event in the 2022-2023 program year. These data are based on predictions for both fixed and variable costs for each event and are documented in the annual program budget. Individuals may request a copy of the Pack budget from the Committee Chair for additional information about assumptions made for each calculation.
