Camp Oest – Navajo Canyon

Camp Location: 1800 Robinson Mill Rd, Darlington, MD 21034 (39.68016, -76.26126)

The Fall camporee is hosted by Harford District and will include Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA participants from several Harford units. Webelos Scouts from Pack 802 are encouraged to camp for the weekend and demonstrate their leadership skills by performing most camp tasks with adult guidance (see reverse). Younger Cub Scouts are invited to join us for the day on Saturday and participate in camporee games and activities. The Camporee stations will be hosted by numerous public servants including Harford Technical Rescue, Emergency Medical Technicians, K9 search and rescue, Maryland Forestry, and Maryland Waterways. **Cost:** This event is free to all pack 802 scouts and family members that register on our website by 10/5. Day participants should eat breakfast before arrival but will be fed lunch and dinner.

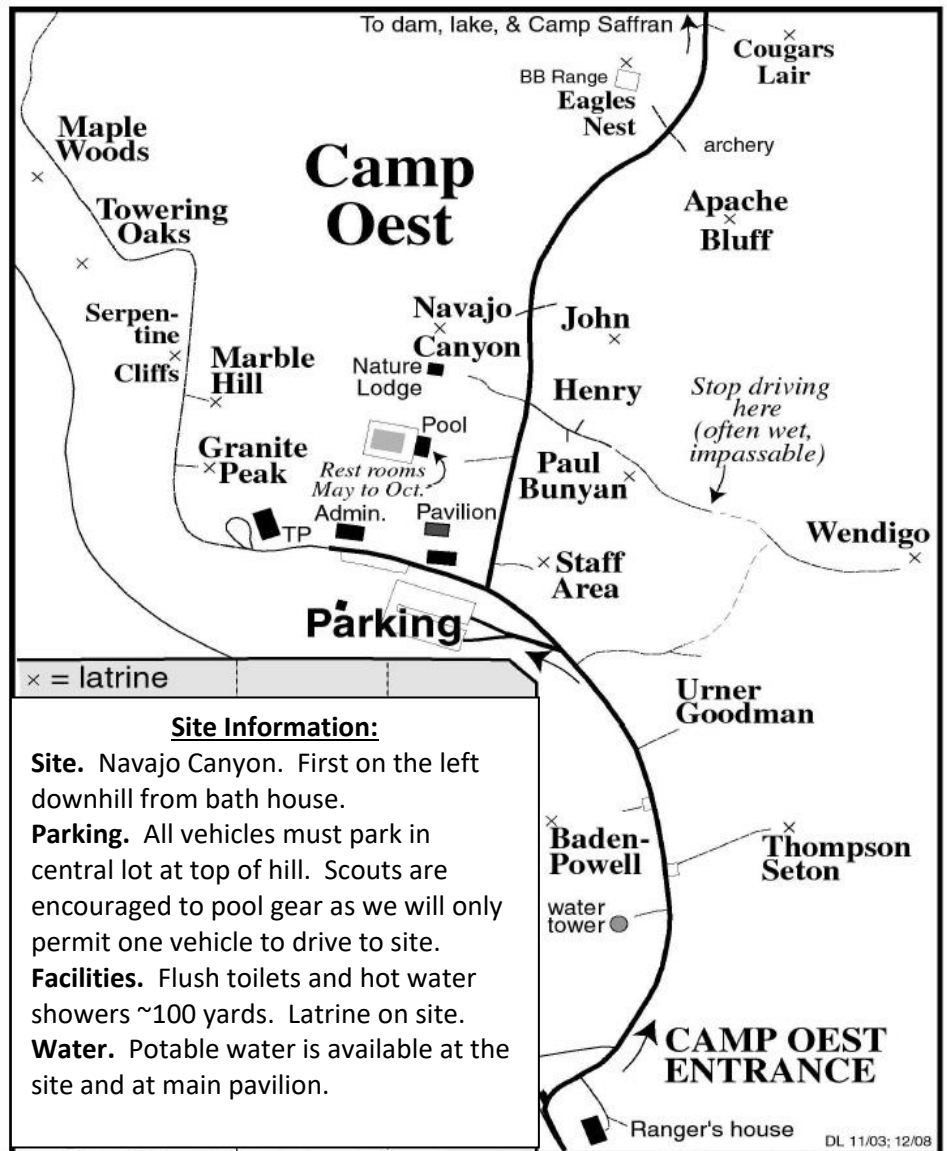

Site Information:

Site. Navajo Canyon. First on the left downhill from bath house.

Parking. All vehicles must park in central lot at top of hill. Scouts are encouraged to pool gear as we will only permit one vehicle to drive to site.

Facilities. Flush toilets and hot water showers ~100 yards. Latrine on site.

Water. Potable water is available at the site and at main pavilion.
